# About the Conference Theme

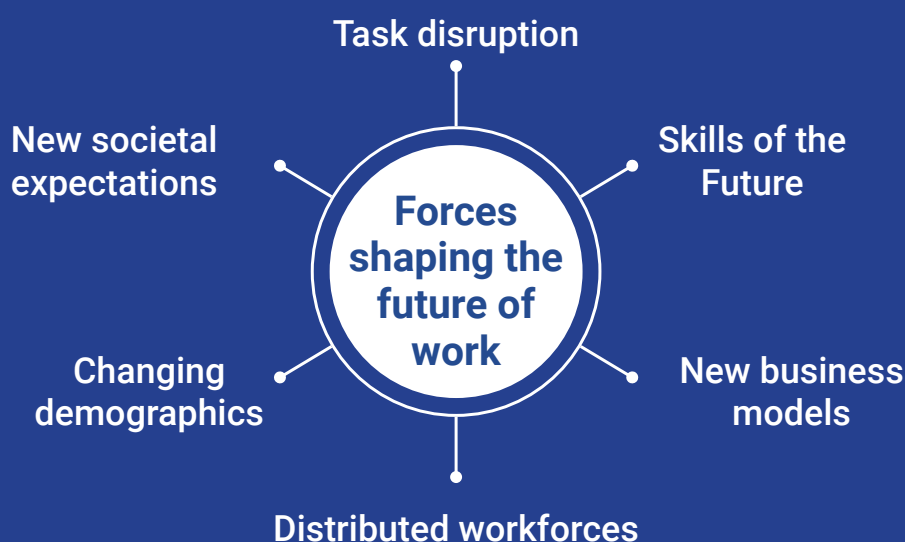
## Reshaping the Future Of HRD In a Fast Changing World
